

Some notes about Final Congress

Location: Quigley, Saturday, April 10

Registration Time: 7:30 – 8:30

How to Register:

You **MUST** register in two places.

Use the Congress **Registration with Form Fields**. This can be found on the Pittsburgh NFL website. Send this as an attachment to Alice ajursin@yahoo.com by **Thursday, April 8 by Noon**

And register at Joy Of Tournaments – This will be available the week before the congress.

What to bring on that day:

The official registration forms with signatures. This is found on the NFL website. You will be able to print this form from JoyOfTournaments.com

National Nominees:

Some students have already received noms in Congresses 1, 2 and 3. See the other attachment: National Noms.

If a student has a nom in the house AND the senate, the coach must decide as to whether they will be representatives or senators. They will then compete according to that designation in both Congress 4 and the Super Session.

Students who have noms MUST BE INCLUDED IN YOUR QUOTA AND MUST COMPETE IN CONGRESS 4

Noms can still be earned in Congress 4. The student must have competed in a previous congress for the nom to be valid. If your school just earned an extra seat and the student is new to the official houses, we will consider attendance in an Unofficial House as competing.

REMEMBER:

Charter Schools may sit two in the Senate. Seats in the House are by apportionment. Please try to fill your slots. The number seated in the house determines the number that can go to nationals.

Affiliate schools may sit two in the Senate and two in the House.

The Pittsburgh District can send two students to the National Tournament in the Senate.

The number of Representatives sent to the National Tournament is dependent upon the number of students seated in the Official Houses. Please participate and try to fill your quota. The apportionment is as follows:

10 to 29 – Sends 1
30 to 60 – Sends 2
61 to 90 – Sends 3
91 + - Sends 4
